IE Award Proposal Title	Summary
Hotel D Exhibit	The Center for Teaching Excellence was awarded support to create a permanent exhibit in Hotel D to share the history of the space and the stories of its inhabitants, particularly the enslaved individuals.
UVA Wise Inclusive Excellence Faculty Mentorship and EJI Memorialization	The UVA Wise Inclusive Excellence plan includes building a faculty peer-mentorship program in support of inclusive learning and classroom environments. This awarded proposal supported the initial wave of development for faculty peer leaders. A second component focused on a learning activity to support ongoing memorialization and local educational work in partnership with EJI.
Open Doors	This awarded proposal sought support to supplement initial investments through the VEST program for a pilot initiative. The initiative seeks to better support a pathway to graduate education by building relationships with faculty and students at two HBCUs in Virginia (VSU and NSU). The program includes a component related to students and a second component encouraging research partnerships among UVA, VSU, and NSU faculty.
CASTL Culture of Inclusion	The Center for Advanced Studies in Teaching and Learning, CASTL, was awarded support to engage in a departmental self-study and action planning process for their specific unit within the broader school inclusive excellence plan framework. The award supported a focus on studying their broader cultural climate.
